

The Odyssey School Summer Camp Application Procedures and Policies

1. Complete and return this application by May 1 to The Odyssey School Summer Camp, 3257 Bridle Ridge Lane, Lutherville, MD 21093.
2. Pre-admission interviews with children may be scheduled to facilitate appropriate academic placement. The Reading-Writing Progress Assessment form will need to be completed in addition to the application. A psycho-educational evaluation and/or speech-language assessment may be required for admission.
3. A non-refundable deposit of \$500 is due within 10 business days upon notification of acceptance. The balance will be due by June 1. Please refer to the tuition insert for tuition rates.
4. All non-Odyssey School campers may be assessed for academic placement. Interviews may be scheduled with children if staff deem it necessary in order to facilitate appropriate academic placement. Current Odyssey School Students will not require academic placement assessment, but must submit a completed application.
5. The Odyssey School Camp reserves the right to require additional information about the applicant following receipt of health information and dyslexia diagnoses.
6. The Odyssey School Summer Camp reserves the right to specify terms of acceptance or to deny admission if, in its sole discretion, it determines that The Odyssey School Summer Camp cannot meet the needs of the applicant. In such a case, any tuition payments already made will be refunded.
7. The Odyssey School Summer Camp reserves the right to request the immediate withdrawal of any Summer Camp participant whose behavior is detrimental to the program. In such case, the participant will be charged for the entire week in which the withdrawal occurs, and a pro-rated refund of tuition for the remaining weeks of the program will be refunded.
8. Anyone withdrawing from The Odyssey School Summer Camp must do so in writing to The Odyssey School Business Office. If the withdrawal is prior to June 5, a refund of the amount paid for the program less a cancellation fee of \$100 and the \$500 non-refundable deposit will be given. If the withdrawal is after June 5 but before June 15, a refund of the amount paid for the program less a cancellation fee of \$500 and the \$500 non-refundable deposit will be given. Thereafter, The Odyssey School Summer Camp will not refund any tuition monies if a camper is withdrawn from the program.
9. The Odyssey School Summer Camp accepts no responsibility for students who remain on the Odyssey School campus after the conclusion of the day's program.
10. The Odyssey School Summer Camp cannot be held responsible for loss or damage to personal property during the operation of the program.
11. Applications are processed on a first-come basis. Enrollment is limited.
